Tim Huddleston is joining the Foundation as its new Regional Vice President. Huddleston grew up on the campus of College of the Ozarks where his father served on staff. He most recently served part-time as Executive Pastor of First Baptist Church of Clever where his wife, Teresa, serves as Children's Ministry Director.

Tim earned a Master's in Business Administration degree from Southwest Baptist University in Bolivar, Missouri, and completed advanced studies in Higher Education Administration at Saint Louis University.

MBF Staff Updates

Missouri Baptist Foundation trustees have approved changes in staff responsibilities to further strengthen its ministry. Shelly Vaughn will serve as Chief Operating Officer (COO), John Long as Controller, Diane Reed as Administrative Assistant to the President and Corporate Secretary and Paula Misloski as Client Services Administrator.

As Chief Operating Officer, Vaughn will be responsible for administering and supervising the operations of the Foundation including accounting, trust administration, risk management, human resources and information technology. The Chief Operating Officer is to coordinate the functions of the Investment Review Committee and assist the President with investment activities as directed by the board of trustees. The COO is also responsible for the review of all financial statements and annual audit. Before taking the role of COO, Shelly has served MBF since May, 1998 in the areas of accounting and trust administration. In 2012, Shelly earned the credential of Certified Trust & Financial Advisor (CTFA).

As Controller, Long will be responsible for supervising the accounting operations of the Foundation following policies, procedures and internal controls. The Controller is to maintain accurate records of the Foundation and its constituency and is also responsible to prepare interim and annual financial statements and prepare for annual audit. John began service with MBF in November, 2009 and has served MBF as accountant and trust accounting manager. John earned the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) title in 2007.

Reed continues serving as Administrative Assistant to the President and now she adds the responsibility of Corporate Secretary of the Board of Trustees. This position insures the corporate resolution documents are prepared and accurate for board approval and implementation. Diane has served with MBF since 1978.

Misloski moves from Ministry Support Coordinator to Client Services Administrator. In the role, she will assist the COO with all phases of trust administration. Paula joined the MBF staff in March, 2017.
